GUIDELINES

FOR THE BUSINESS COMMUNITIES OF BOSNIA AND HERZEGOVINA AND THE REPUBLIC OF SERBIA

on how to use assistance of the Turkish Commercial Counsellors and Attaches worldwide

These guidelines are prepared to operationalize the conclusions of the ministers of trade and economy of Bosnia and Herzegovina, the Republic of Serbia and the Republic of Turkey as laid down in the "Declaration on Economic and Commercial Cooperation among Bosnia and Herzegovina, the Republic of Turkey and the Republic of Serbia", the "2016-2018 Medium Term Program on Trade and Economic Cooperation" (Medium Term Program) and the corresponding activities set in the Action Plan.

Namely, the three countries agreed in the Medium Term Program to pay particular attention and provide institutional support to cooperation in third countries' markets. To this end, corresponding activities were scheduled in the Action Plan (item 1.3. and sub-items 1.3.1 and 1.3.2).

The guidelines are intended to:

- provide necessary information to the stakeholders on what kind of assistance can be obtained from the Turkish Commercial Counsellors and Attaches worldwide;
- list the conditions needed to be met so as to be eligible for such assistance;
- set out clear procedural steps to be followed in seeking assistance.

1. What kind of assistance can be requested?

Below is the general list of assistance that can be requested:

Legal and Regulatory Issues:

- Text or excerpt of the specific trade-related legislation or regulation;
- Requirements for establishment in the territory of the country concerned;
- Existence of import or export limitations;
- Taxes and charges;
- Currency and payment system;
- Public procurement procedure;

Documentation and Product Requirements

- Required export/import documents;
- Product certification requirements;
- Labelling requirements;

Other information

- Most appropriate institutional contact for a specific issue in the country concerned;
- Where to find industry-specific trade data and analysis;
- Country-specific tariff and trade agreement information;

2. What conditions have to be met?

In order to be eligible to ask for assistance of the specific Turkish Commercial Counsellor the following conditions have to be met:

- Requesting legal person has be the one established in Bosnia and Herzegovina or the Republic of Serbia having its registered seat, central management or main place of business in the territory of Bosnia and Herzegovina or the Republic of Serbia;
- The home country of the legal person asking assistance does not have resident diplomatic representation in the country concerned (see the list provided in Annex I to these Guidelines).

Requests made by legal persons failing to meet the above conditions shall not be processed.

3. Steps to be followed in asking for assistance

Legal person eligible to ask for assistance of the Turkish Commercial Counsellors has to comply with following steps:

- Step 1. Fill-in the form provided in the Annex II
- Step 2. Send the form to the Turkish Commercial Representation Office of the desired country
- Step 3. Send the form to the designated contact in the Ministry of Foreign Trade and Economic Relations of Bosnia and Herzegovina or the Ministry of Trade, Tourism and Telecommunications of the Republic of Serbia

Done on 25 October 2016 and adopted on 26 October 2016 both in Istanbul.
